1. I attest that I am a parent, guardian, or other person having legal custody of the children listed, that I am the supervisor of the home education program and am responsible for the provision of instruction in the home education program, and that I have earned a high school diploma.
2. I attest that the home education program will be in compliance with Section 13-1327.1 of the Pennsylvania School Code.
3. I attest that the subjects listed in paragraph four below will be offered in the English language for a minimum of 180 days or 900 hours for elementary students and 180 days or 990 hours for secondary students.
4. I attest that the following courses shall be taught at the elementary level: English, to include spelling, reading and writing; arithmetic; science; geography, history of the United States and Pennsylvania; civics; safety education, including regular and continuous instruction in the dangers and prevention of fires; health and physiology; physical education; music and art. I attest that the following courses shall be taught at the secondary level: English, to include language, literature, speech and composition; science; geography; social studies, to include civics, world history, history of the United States and Pennsylvania; mathematics, to include general mathematics, algebra, and geometry; art; music; physical education; health; and safety education, including regular and continuous instruction in the dangers and prevention of fires. Other Courses may be included at the discretion of the supervisor.
5. I attest that the educational objectives in the home education program are by subject area as attached to this affidavit.
6. I attest that the children have been immunized against the following diseases pursuant to Section 1303(c) and (d) of Pennsylvania Statutes Annotated: a. Diphtheria; b. Tetanus; c. Poliomyelitis; d. Measles (Rubeola); e. German Measles (Rubella); f. Mumps g. Hepatitis B h. Chickenpox (varicella) or evidence of immunity or have a medical, religious, or ethical exemption.
7. I attest that the children have received the health and medical services required by Article XIV of the Public School Code. A comprehensive health record shall be maintained for each child. (Article XIV requires that every child of school age be given by methods established by the state's Advisory Health Board, an annual vision test, a hearing test, a measurement of height and weight, tests for tuberculosis under medical supervision and other tests required by the Advisory Health Board. Children upon entry into school and in the 6th and 11th grades must have a medical examination and comprehensive appraisal of health by a physician. Children upon entry into school and in the 3rd and 7th grades must have a dental examination by a dentist.)
8. I attest that no adult living in the home, including the undersigned supervisor, and no person having legal custody of the children named in this affidavit has been convicted within five years of today's date of any of the following offenses under Section 111 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes.  
(1) An offense under one or more of the following provisions of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes: Chapter 25 (relating to criminal homicide); Section 3126 (relating to indecent assault); Section 2702 (relating to aggravated assault); Section 3127 (relating to indecent exposure); Former section 2709(b) (relating to stalking); Section 4302 (relating to incest); Section 2709.1 (relating to stalking); Section 4303 (relating to concealing death of child); Section 2901 (relating to kidnapping); Section 4304 (relating to endangering welfare of children); Section 2902 (relating to unlawful restraint); Section 4305 (relating to dealing in infant children); Section 3121 (relating to rape); A felony offense under section 5902(b) (relating to prostitution and related offenses).; Section 3122.1 (relating to statutory sexual assault). Section 5903(c) or (d) (relating to obscene and other sexual materials and performances); Section 3123 (relating to involuntary deviate sexual intercourse); Section 6301 (relating to corruption of minors); Section 3124.1 (relating to sexual assault). Section 6312 (relating to sexual abuse of children); Section 3125 (relating to aggravated indecent assault).  
(2) An offense designated as a felony under the act of April 14, 1972 (P.L. 233, No. 64), known as "The Controlled Substance, Drug, Device and Cosmetic Act."  
(3) An out-of-State or Federal offense similar in nature to those crimes listed in clauses (1) and (2).
